$$\frac{4x+16}{5x^4} \cdot \frac{x+5}{3x+12}$$
$$\frac{4(x+4)}{5x^4} \cdot \frac{(x+5)}{3(x+4)} = \frac{4(x+5)}{15x^4}$$
